Small file sizes since it uses vector graphics.

Convert files to portable document format (pdf) files

Advantages:

Smaller file size

Cross platform

Prints perfectly unlike Word documents which are font dependent

Can imbed links

Can lock documents

Impatica for PowerPoint <http://www.impatica.com/imp4ppt/>

Compresses PowerPoint files to files suitable for streaming over the internet.

Advantages:

Small file sizes (95% smaller than PPT files saved for web)

Completely cross platform

Easy to use

Synchronize video with PPT

Searchable text

Built in indexes and navigation

Distribute short lectures over the web or longer lectures on DVD.
